

It does not constitute authority under K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a, to construct any dam or other obstruction. It does not give authority to access any right-of-way, or authorize injury to, or trespass upon, public or private property, nor does it obviate the necessity of obtaining assent from Federal or Local Governmental authorities, when necessary. for a term permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, together with the maps, plans and other submitted data, and that the application is hereby approved and the applicant is hereby authorized, subject to vested rights and prior appropriations, to proceed with the construction of the proposed diversion works (except those dams and stream obstructions regulated by K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a, as amended), and to proceed with all steps necessary for the application of the water to the approved and proposed beneficial use subject to the following terms, conditions and limitations:

- 1. That the priority date assigned to such application is **February 6, 2014**.
- 2. That the water sought to be appropriated shall be used for industrial purposes within a two mile radius of the proposed point of diversion located in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¼ NE¼ NE¼) of Section 14, in Township 11 South, Range 18 West, Ellis County, Kansas.
- 3. That the authorized source from which the appropriation shall be made is groundwater, to be withdrawn by means of one (1) well located in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¼ NE¼ NE½) of Section 14, more particularly described as being near a point 4,897 feet North and 364 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 11 South, Range 18 West, Ellis County, Kansas located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application.
- 4. That the appropriation sought shall be limited to a maximum diversion rate not in excess of **100** gallons per minute and to a quantity not to exceed **1.629 million gallons** (5 acre-feet) of water for any calendar year.
- 5. That the use of water herein authorized shall not be made so as to impair any use under existing water rights nor prejudicially and unreasonably affect the public interest.
- 6. That the right of the appropriator shall relate to a specific quantity of water and such right must allow for a reasonable raising or lowering of the static water level and for the reasonable increase or decrease of the streamflow at the appropriator's point of diversion.
- 7. That this permit does not constitute authority under K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a to construct any dam or other obstruction; nor does it grant any right-of-way, or authorize entry upon or injury to, public or private property.

8. That all diversion works constructed under the authority of this permit into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic quick-closing, check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

- 9. That an acceptable water flow meter shall be installed and maintained on the diversion works authorized by this permit in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. This water flow meter shall be used to provide an accurate quantity of water diverted as required for the annual water use report (including the meter reading at the beginning and end of the report year).
- 10. That the applicant shall maintain accurate and complete records from which the quantity of water diverted during each calendar year may be readily determined and the applicant shall file an annual water use report with the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year. Failure to file the annual water use report by the due date shall cause the applicant to be subject to a civil penalty.
- 11. That no water user shall engage in nor allow the waste of any water diverted under the authority of this permit.
- 12. That failure without cause to comply with provisions of the permit and its terms, conditions and limitations will result in the forfeiture of the priority date, revocation of the permit and dismissal of the application.
- 13. That the right to appropriate water under authority of this permit is subject to any minimum desirable streamflow requirements identified and established pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-703c for the source of supply to which this water right applies.
- 14. That the applicant waives any right to a hearing on the matter of abandonment and termination, and that any right of appropriation perfected pursuant to this term permit shall be declared abandoned and terminated on **February 1**, **2020**, and its priority forfeited. Any extension of time to make use of water as authorized herein must be requested in writing for good cause by the applicant prior to the expiration date on this permit.

This is a final agency action. If you choose to appeal this decision or any finding or part thereof, you must do so by filing a petition for review in the manner prescribed by the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions (KJRA K.S.A. 77-601 et seq.) within 30 days of service of this order. Your appeal must be made with the appropriate district court for the district of Kansas. The Chief Legal Counsel for the Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, is the agency officer who will receive service of a petition for judicial review on behalf of the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources.
