Thayne A. Larson on behalf of Bestifor Farms owner of the referenced water rights has filed applications for approval to change the points of diversion authorized for irrigation use under the referenced files. The applications were received on august 12, 2019.

The referenced water rights are considered in good standing as per K.S.A. 82a-718 and 82a-732. File No. 40,409 was issued a violation notice of non-compliance, for exceeding the authorized quantity of by less than one (1) acre-foot. The pumping and MDS restrictions for this junior right are partially the reasoning behind the requested changes. The applications comply with K.A.R. 5-5-2a, *Complete change application*.

File No. 9,105 authorizes two (2) wells in the Southeast Quarter of 36-5-3W, Cloud County with the well in the SE¼ NE¼ SE¼ and assigned 44 acre-feet (AF) at a rate of 175 gallons per minute (gpm), referenced as the East Well. The well referenced as the West Well located in the N½ SW¼ SE¼ is authorized 87AF at a rate of 350 gpm, will remain as authorized, but will be updated to be North Well under this right.

File No. 40,409, is authorized one(1) point of diversion, to divert 27 acre-feet at a rate of 250 gallons per minute. The proposal is to flip the rate and quantity under File No. 40,409 with the well referenced as the East Well under File No. 9,105, located in the SE1/4 NE1/4 SE1/4 and assigned 44 acre-feet (AF) at a rate of 175 gpm. The actual feet distances of the well locations will be added to the referenced files. No new wells will be drilled. The referenced files, and File No. 27,768, have a complete overlap in the place of use of 201.5 acres. All three rights have a combined total of 152 AF providing 1.09 acre-foot (13.1 inches) per acre. There are no additional limitations on the rights, but File No. 40,409 is subject to MDS resulting in pumping restrictions that were enforced 2014,15,16 & 18. The rights are in the Effective Alluvial, Special Use Area (Code 034) of the Republican River and appear to be in an area that is closed to new appropriations. The junior right has a designated source of supply, Main Stem Alluvium (Code 113), with File No. 9,105, shown with CIN 5 as Main Stem Alluvium (Code 113) and CIN 4 as Terrace (Code 115) and Dakota Aquifer System (Code 330). The original permit application for File No. 9,105, lists the well in the SW1/4SE1/4 (CIN 4) as 52 feet deep, also referenced as Well #1, and the well in the NE1/4SE1/4 (CIN 5) to be 98 feet deep. The application under File No. 40,409 states the well to be 47 feet deep. No well logs for the rights were located.

The proposed "Flip-Flop" will move the 44 AF at a rate of 175 gpm under File No. 9,105, CIN 5, to the Southwest to the well described as being near the center of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter NC SW½ SE½, (South Well) that was authorized by File No. 40,409. The feet distances of this well were determined by the Staff of the Stockton Field Office to be 751 feet North and 2,046 feet West, it appears the description can be updated to being in the NW½ SW½ SE½, and the comment updated to South Well. The 27 AF at 250 gpm that is under File No. 40,409, will move to the well in the NE½ NE½ NW¼, that had been pumped under File No. 9,105, all in Section 36, Township 2 South, Range 3 West, Cloud County. The well locations indicate that the proposed move is approximately 1,964 feet between the two wells. The flip is between the wells that have been designated as Main Stem Alluvium so the change will not alter the source of supply.

A review of the well locations and the path of Oak Creek, located to the North, indicates the wells are similar distance from the creek and comply with K.A.R. 5-5-13, Relocation of alluvial wells. As no new wells will be drilled, and each right will continue to authorize the same number of wells, K.A.R. 5-5-16, Additional well, will not apply to the changes.

Review of File No. 40,409 found a 1998 investigation regarding impairment of File No. 8,153 believed to be caused by nearby rights. It appears this was resolved, and no additional complaints were received. The change will move a right authorized a larger quantity away from the well under File No. 8,153. Additionally, the proposed existing well under File No. 40,409, will be subject to Minimum Desirable Stream Flow restrictions and not authorized to pump when conditions are dry and stream levels are low.

The nearby wells consist of the two (2) irrigation wells under the referenced files and within one-half (½) mile of the proposed existing well under File No. 9,105. Under File No. 40,409 there are three (3) irrigation wells, two under the referenced files and the irrigation well under File No. 8,153, The applicant does not indicate any domestic wells located in the area. A comment letter was sent to all the owner of File No. 8,153. No comments of any kind were received in this office further indicating the historical impairment issue was resolved.

The well spacings will not change as no new wells are being drilled. There are no nearby domestic wells indicated in the area. File No. 40,409, will be moving more than 300 feet and towards the location authorized under File No. 8,153. The proposed existing well for File No. 40,409, is approximately 1,080 feet away from the well under File No. 8,153, based on recent GPS values. This is less 1,320 feet as required for nondomestic wells sourced as alluvium per K.A.R. 5-4-4, *Well spacing*. A **waiver of well to well spacing** for the requested change under File No. 40,409 was requested by the applicant and has been prepared. The change will result in the 128 acre-feet authorized by File No. 9,105 to be 426 feet apart, but as the wells are under the same priority, serving the same place of use impairment should not be an issue. Also these two wells are at a different depth. The reduction in spacing between the wells under File No. 9,105, appears to comply with part (a) of K.A.R. 5-4-4.

Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton City Field Office was contacted for a recommendation on the proposed changes. In his email dated December 23, 2019, he recommended approval with the requested waiver under File No. 40,409.

Water flowmeters will be required on the points of diversion and a check valve will also be required if chemigating. A water level measurement tube and WWC-5 will not be required as the wells are existing. No letter will be sent to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment as the currently authorized wells will remain authorized.

Based on the above discussion, and approval of the requested waiver of K.A.R. 5-4-4, that no change in the local source of supply should occur, that the changes are reasonable, and that possible impairment to existing water rights will be reduced, it is recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

- 1. That K.A.R. 5-4-4(c)(1)(C) states in part an application to change the point of diversion shall meet the spacing requirements established by K.A.R. 5-4-4 or not decrease the distance to other wells by more than 300 feet, and that well spacing shall be sufficient to prevent direct impairment in this case 1,320 feet.
- 2. That File No. 40,409 is requesting to move approximately 1,963 well an existing well located approximately 1,000 feet from the well authorized by File No. 8,153. The owner has requested a waiver of the stated 1,320 feet well to well spacing
- 3. These two wells were listed on the application to be 850 feet apart. A review of the GPS data indicated them to be 1,080 feet apart. Both measurements between these existing wells are less than the required 1,320 feet of well to well spacing.
- 4. The change will result in a decrease of pumping from the currently authorized 44 acre-feet at 175 gallons per minute to 27 acre-feet at 250 gallons per minute.
- 5. Review of the files found a 1998 request for an impairment investigation by the previous owner of File No. 8,513. There does not appear to have been any additional impairment issues with File No. 8,153 that has been under the same ownership since 2006. This owner was informed by letter of the requested change. No comment of any kind was received.
- 6. The change will result in a well to be authorized by an appropriation that is significantly lower in priority that the nearby well and subject to the restrictions of Minimal Desirable Stream Flow, restricting pumping during times when stream flow is reduced.
- 7. The reduced quantity and restricted pumping should help assure that impairment between these two wells will not become an issue.



This is to advise you that applications for approval of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, to change the points of diversion authorized under the above referenced files.

The applications are proposing to reassign quantity and rate between the existing wells authorized by the referenced files. The overall quantity and rates developed by the rights will not be increased. Under File No. 9,105 only one(1) of the two(2) wells will change locations with File No. 40,409. The second well under File No. 9,105, located in the North half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (N½ SW¼ SE¼) of Section 36, in Township 5 South, Range 3 West, Cloud County, is proposed to remain as authorized to divert 84 acre-feet of water per calendar year and at a diversion rate not in excess of 350 gallons per minute (0.78 c.f.s.).



The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Thayne Larson on behalf of Bestifor Farms, PO Box 220, Belleville, Kansas 66935, received in the office of the Chief Engineer on August 12, 2019, for approval of a change in the location of the point of diversion under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Orders of the Chief Engineer dated May 10, 2007, March 11, 2013 and July 7, 2014, approving the applications to change the place of use, finds that the changes are reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized points of diversion shall be:

one(1) well located in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW½ SW½ SE½) of Section 36, more particularly described as being near a point 751 feet North and 2,046 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, at a diversion rate not in excess of 175 gallons per minute (0.39 c.f.s.) and a quantity not to exceed 44 acre-feet per calendar year and

one(1) well located in the North half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (N½ SW¼ SE¼) of Section 36, more particularly described as being near a point 1,177 feet North and 2,063 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, at a diversion rate not in excess of 350 gallons per minute (0.78 c.f.s.) and a quantity not to exceed 84 acrefeet per calendar year

both in Township 5 South, Range 3 West, Cloud County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the point of diversion.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2020, or within any authorized extension of time. The applicant shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line. automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 9,105, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated March 19, 1979, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
