Mark and Lanae Schamberger, owners of the referenced groundwater right, filed an application proposing to change the authorized use made of water from stockwatering to domestic use in the Prairie Dog Creek drainage basin.

The referenced file is not abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

It is proposed that the authorized use made of water under the water right be changed from stockwatering use to domestic use for an existing cattle feedlot located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW¼ NE¾) of Section 4, Township 7 South, Range 28 West, Sheridan County, Kansas. No actual change in use will occur and therefore no substantial increase in consumptive use. There is no actual change in the use of water, the use of water now qualifies as domestic use instead of the originally defined stockwater use. There is no change in the authorized quantity (4.269 m.g.y.) or authorized place of use. The referenced file number has no overlaps in the place of use or point of diversion.

Nearby domestic well identified on the map within one half-mile of the authorized point of diversion were notified of the proposed change in use made of water by letters dated April 13, 2020 in order to comply with K.S.A. 82a-1906.

The source of supply will not change, previously determined to be Ogallala formation (211).

In an e-mail dated April 13, 2020, Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton Field Office, indicated no objection to approval of the application.

In an e-mail dated April 15, 2020, Shannon Kenyon, Manager of the Northwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 4, indicated recommendation to approve the change use made of water of the application.

A check valve will be required if foreign substances are injected into the diverted water. Additionally, a water meter will no longer be required but encouraged to aid in their water use reporting (non-mandatory).

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced application be approved.



RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
