Pessemier Company and Christian A. Royer, water right owners, filed applications for approval to change the authorized point of diversion for the referenced file numbers both authorized groundwater in the Kansas River Basin. The referenced change applications were filed along with Application, File No. 50,192 processed by Doug Schemm, Environmental Scientist of the Topeka Field Office.

The referenced file numbers do not appear abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

The referenced file numbers are authorized irrigation use from the same well for irrigation of the same 335 acres in Sections 7 and 8, Township 10 South, Range 12 East, Wabaunsee County. The place of use is also overlapped by Water Right, File Nos. 36,961; 36,962; 43,700; 43,701 and Application, File No. 50,192. The applicants propose to add a new well to File Nos. 39,253 and 43,699, creating a battery of two wells with a geographic center 3,110 feet North and 4,492 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 8. The battery will overlap that proposed for File No. 50,192, and the change involves a distance move for File Nos. 39,253 and 43,699 of approximately 148 feet to the north.

The application appears to meet K.A.R. 5-2-3 *Battery of wells*. The time to construct the diversion works has expired, and the proposed battery meets the definition of a battery of wells. The safe yield calculation for File No. 50,192 indicates the proposed geocenter still meets safe yield. The applicant identified three wells within one-half mile of the proposed point of diversion, two of which are owned by the applicant. The proposed point of diversion (battery geo-center) is located 1,022 feet from one of the applicant's existing irrigation wells, which is less than the minimum well spacing of 1,320 feet. However, the applications meet well spacing requirements of K.A.R. 5-4-4 since they do not decrease the distance to other wells or authorized well locations by more than 300 feet, and the proposed spacing improves the current spacing between the applicant's wells,

Doug sent a nearby notification letter on February 20, 2019 to the other well owner, including notification of the proposed change applications, no response was received.

The same local source of supply will not change, previously determined to be Recent (110)\Main Stem Alluvium (113).

In an e-mail dated May 23, 2019, Katherine Tietsort, Water Commissioner of the Topeka Field Office, indicated no objection to approval of the referenced applications.

A water flow meter and a water level measurement tube are required. A check valve is required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended the referenced applications be approved.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Pessemier Company and Christian A. Royer, P.O. Box 206, Saint Marys, Kansas, 66536, received in this office on January 3, 2019, for approval of a change in the location of the point of diversion under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated July 23, 1999, approving the application to change the place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the point of diversion shall be:

a battery of two (2) wells with a geographic center located in Lot 5 of Section 8, more particularly described as being near a point 3,110 feet North and 4,492 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section,

in Township 10 South, Range 12 East, Wabaunsee County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the point of diversion.

The point of diversion described herein as a battery of two (2) wells is further limited such that the wells shall be located within a three hundred (300) foot radius circle, in the same local source of supply.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2020, or within any authorized extension of time. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All wells with a diversion rate of 100 gallons per minute or more drilled under the authority of this order shall have a tube or other device installed in a manner acceptable to, and in accordance with specifications adopted by, the Chief Engineer. This tube or device shall be suitable for making water level measurements and shall be maintained in a condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 39,253, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 2, 1999, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
