Bernice A. Leidig Trust filed the above referenced application to appropriate surface water for irrigation use form the Republican River. This new application would provide an additional quantity of water and rate of diversion from an existing pump site currently authorized under Water Right, File No. 43,161. Due to the complexities in pumping scenarios and conditioning of this new application, the original application was returned to the applicant on January 9, 2019 providing 30 days to provide additional information about the application (see cover letter dated January 9, 2019).

The cover letter outlined several pumping scenarios and requested that the applicant acknowledge their understanding of the discussion, by signing the cover letter and returning a signed copy of the letter to our office, with the original application.

The original application and requested information were not returned by the deadline, nor was there a request for an extension of time. FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION FILE NO. 50,015

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

FINDINGS

- 1. That on March 19, 2018, the Chief Engineer received an application from Bernice A. Leidig Trust for permit to appropriate surface water for beneficial use, assigned File No. 50,015, proposing the appropriation of 141.6 acre-feet of water, at a maximum requested diversion rate of 950 gallons per minute, for irrigation use. The point of diversion was one (1) pump site located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼ SE¼ NW¼) of Section 28, more particularly described as being near a point 3,100 feet North and 2,800 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 8 South, Range 4 East, Clay County, Kansas.
- 2. That on January 9, 2019, the original application was returned to the applicant, with a cover letter requesting that additional information be submitted in order to complete the application. The cover letter outlined several pumping scenarios and requested that the applicant acknowledge their understanding of the discussion, by signing the cover letter and returning a signed copy of the letter to our office, along with the original application. The applicant was provided a deadline until February 9, 2019, the time in which to provide the requested information and return the original application. The applicant was informed that the application would be dismissed if it was not returned by the February 9, 2019 deadline, or within any authorized extension of time.
- 3. That the original application was not returned by the February 9, 2019 deadline, nor was there any request for an extension of time.
- 4. That the application should be dismissed and its priority forfeited as provided by K.S.A. 82a-710, for failure to return the application.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, in accordance with the law, Application, File No. 50,015, is herewith dismissed and the priority assigned to it is considered to be forfeited.



Dear Mr. Leidig:

The above referenced original application, File No. 50,015 for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use is being returned to you for additional information. We have suspended processing of this application. Application, File No. 50,015 is requesting to appropriate 141.6 acre-feet of surface water per calendar year from Mall Creek in the Republican River basin, for irrigation use, to be diverted at a maximum rate of 950 gallons per minute. This new application would provide an additional quantity of water and rate of diversion from an existing pump site currently authorized under Water Right, File No. 43,161. The specific pump site is located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE½ SE½ NW½) of Section 28, (3,100' North and 2,800' West of the Southeast corner of said section) in Township 8 South, Range 4 East, Clay County, Kansas. This junior file will be limited to 141.6 acre-feet at 950 gallons per minute with the senior file, providing 48.6 acre-feet of additional water, and 380 gallons per minute of additional rate.

Your existing file, Water Right, File No. 43,161 is authorized 93 acre-feet at 570 gallons per minute. All applications to appropriate surface water from the Republican River are subject to specific conditions, per K.A.R 5-3-11(d)(6), as follows:

- 1) Exercising the right will cause impairment.
- 2) Minimum Desirable Streamflow (MDS) administration is occurring at the Clay Center gage.
- 3) MDS administration is occurring at the Concordia gage, or
- 4) The Chief Engineer is enforcing Paragraph 6(b) of the Milford Reservation Right.

You received a letter dated March 13, 2015 that further provided that the Chief Engineer would allow permission to exercise your existing right if flows are 80 c.f.s. or greater as measured at the Clay Center U.S.G.S. gage, whether or not MDS administration is occurring. However, this will not be the case under your new File No. 50,015. Your new application, File No. 50,015 will be allowed permission only when MDS is not occurring as identified in the 4 conditions above.

What this means is if you put this new file on the existing pump site, you would be granted permission on the senior file during MDS as long as there is 80 c.f.s. at the Clay Center gage, and you haven't pumped past the proportional 93 acrefeet under the senior file, but you would not be granted permission under this new file. Meaning you would physically have to restrict your pumping rate to the 570 authorized under the senior file. Once you have exhausted the senior file, you cannot be granted any permission to pump under File No. 50,015 so you will not be able to pump. If you haven't exceeded the proportion of the senior file, you can opt to physically restrict diversions to 570 gpm or less and pump up to the remainder of the 93 acre-feet. File No. 50,015, both in rate and quantity, cannot be pumped when MDS is occurring.

Leidig File Nos. 43,161 and 50,015 Page 2

One way to mitigate this is you could, instead, modify your application to request a second pump site to pump the junior file from so that pumping occurs under the senior file when MDS is not occurring, thus you would be able to be granted to pump the remainder of the senior file at the 570 gpm by moving to the senior pumpsite if MDS occurs. The senior pump sites must be off-set by 25 feet to 50 feet. You would physically have to move your pump over to accomplish this.

If we process this new application has filed on the same pump site, then if you are pumping at 950 gpm, the first 570 gpm (and related quantity of water) is counted toward your senior file, and the remaining rate and quantity of water is counted toward your junior file. You are diverting water under both files when you are diverting at any rate greater than 570 gpm.

However, if you install a second (separate) pump site, the junior file would have a different point of diversion. So if you were pumping at 950 gpm from this second pump site, and no water from the senior pump site location, all of the pumped water would be accounted for under the junior file only. Though you must still physically reduce your pumping rate, you would be able to pump more water to your crops. We have an enclosed an example sheet illustrating this.

In any case you must be able to physically restrict your pumping rate to 570 gpm when MDS is occurring.

Please acknowledge your understanding of the above discussion, by signing below and returning the signed copy of this letter to our office. Significant fines can result from any violation of these conditions and we need to be sure you understand this issue.

In order for the application to retain its priority of filing, the original application and attachments must be returned, with the requested information, to this office on or before <u>February 9, 2019</u>, or within any authorized extension of time thereof. Pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-710, failure to timely refile the completed application and attachments as outlined above shall constitute forfeiture of your priority date and result in dismissal of the application.

I have read and understand the discussion detailed in this letter regarding the pumping of surface water from the Republican River and specifically acknowledge that when MDS is occurring and permission is granted, I must physically restrict my diversions to the 570 gpm or less authorized by the Water Right, File No. 43,161 and I cannot continue to pump water at any rate greater than that value.

43161-93 AF @ 570 gpm

50015- 141.6 AF @ 950 gpm

Scenario 1:

Same pumpsite (as filed)
No MDS, permission granted under both.
Pump 125 AF @ 950 gpm.
570 gpm towards 43161 = 75 AF
Remaining 380 gpm towards 50015 = 30 AF

Scenario 2:

Same pumpsite (as filed)
Pump 50 AF @ 950 gpm then MDS occurs. So as above,
43161 has pumped 30 AF and 50015 has pumped 20 AF.
Permission only allowed under 43161.
43161 has 63 AF at 570 gpm left to pump. 50015 cannot be pumped.

Scenario 3:

Different pumpsites.

Start year no MDS. Allowed permission under both.

You start on the junior pump site whenever no MDS is occurring.

Pumped 50 AF @ 950 gpm on pump site for 50015. All is accounted towards 50015.

Then MDS, so no permission under 50015 and you have only 43161 left.

Move pump to senior pump site,

In this case you would have 91.5AF @ 570 gpm left to pump under 43161 without violating the overall 141.6 AF allowed under both.

Your application for permit to appropriate water in 28-8-4E in Clay County, was received and has been assigned the file number noted above.

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. Once review of your application has begun, we will contact you, if additional information is required.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water as proposed prior to approval of the application is unlawful. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor . . .

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
