- Really liked; Providing equity and we are senior
- Pg 5 Oral add something like; We are hopeful as you finalize the IMP's that the State will respond to these questions.
- Stress; we were first so we should be compensated
- Additional conclusion comments; We think you have to have a healthy SW component so that other benefits such as Recreations and the Environment. Need to be involved from the beginning and administer rights in such a way that recognizes these other benefits from decade ago, citizens from the US agreed to invest money decades ago and should continue to see the benefits of that investment that we have a right to protect.
- Remove item 12 from the written comments.
- Point out; It is our understanding that we will be curtailed 2 out of 10 years. Please provide us with the modeling that shows our predicted curtailment time.
- Remove from pg 6; SW should be given a share. (We are senior, not junior.)
