Team,

Does anyone know anything about Jim Schneider? He apparently started with NE DNR in November.

Sorry I have not been able to do a summary of our E.C. call last week. On the point of their proposed model change, Jim said they were very concerned about this issue. They are pressing for its consideration at this meeting and as they indicate below, it appears they will not approve an accounting for 2006 without it. I said that this is a significant change from the current procedure and must be considered carefully and said we need to fulfill the assignments of the Administration (do the accounting according to current procedures).

They are focused on the language of the settlement, believing the current procedure counts CU of imported water. Their paper was not an attempt to address all water budget components. When they refer to CU in the paper, they are talking about impacts on RR baseflows only (at least I think that is what I was hearing).

They think the formulation of model runs and accounting they advocate will allow the isolation of CU of the IWS that that they believe is being incorrectly counted in the accounting.
